March 1

Discernment May our children have discernment to know what is truly divine and miraculous and what is only imitation and false so they will not be led astray.

Exodus 7:10-12 NIV

March 2

Repentance

Unlike Pharaoh who displayed only a temporary repentance, may our children have a godly sorrow and true heart repentance that leads to salvation and obedience.

Exodus 10:16, 20 NIV

March 3

No Other God May our children's generation avoid trusting in anything or anyone but the one true and living God through Jesus Christ our Lord. May they abandon anything that gets in the way of their worship and relationship with Him. **Exodus 20:2-3 NIV**

March 4

Idols May God hold central place in our children's lives and may He receive all their affection and devotion. May they refrain from letting money, fame, work or pleasure identify them, give them meaning, make them feel secure, steel their focus, control their thoughts or become their idol.

Exodus 20:4 NIV

March 5

Honor His Name May our children's generation be a people who honors God's name and does not repeat it in vain or misuse it with false affirmations or profanity. **Exodus 20:7 NIV, ***

March 6

Remember the Sabbath

Father, remind our children to remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. **Exodus 20:8 NKJV, ***

March 7

Honor your Parents

Holy Spirit, help our children to honor their mother and father by being courteous, obedient and respectful and may they speak well of them and politely to them.

Exodus 20:12 NKJV

March 8

Adultery May our children be a generation that honors the sanctity of marriage and does not commit adultery. **Exodus 20:14 NIV**

March 9

Stealing May our children learn at an early age how to respect each other's personal property. May they never steal or justify the smallest theft by calling it borrowing. **Exodus 20:15 NIV**



March 10

No False Testimonies May our children's integrity and concern for others cause them to honor their neighbors and speak only the truth about them. **Exodus 20:16 NIV**

March 11

Do not Covet Father, cause our children to be without envy of those who have more than them. May Your provision be enough to keep them content and satisfied. **Exodus 20:17 NIV**

March 12

Faith, Obedience Like Joshua and the people of Israel, may our children have the faith and obedience to do exactly as the Lord prompts them to do no matter how impossible or big the visible giant in their life looks to them. **Joshua 6:6-11, 16 NIV**

March 13

God's Way Father, enable our children to overcome their preconceived notions of how to fight the invisible battles they face and give them divine strategies, courage and faith to do it Your way. **Joshua 6:3-5 NIV**

March 14

Wisdom, Favor As our children grow, may they be like Jesus, increasing in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man. **Luke 2:52 NKJV, ***

March 15

Faith Like Joshua, may our children go out on a limb with God and exercise their faith muscles. As they apply their faith to the situations, relationships, attitudes, problems and issues they face, may they see the visible walls of impossibility come down.
Joshua 6:20 NIV

March 16

Shout to the Lord As God shows a display of His greatness on our children's behalf, may they shout to the Lord with an offering of praise and give Him all the glory for removing the obstacles they face. **Joshua 6:17- 19 NIV**

March 17

God Honoring Actions
Unlike Jacob who reacted and fled secretly in fear, may our children inquire of the Lord, follow His direction and have actions that are honoring and consistent with God's character as they follow His instructions. **Genesis 31:3,17-21 NIV**

March 18

No Sign Needed Unlike Gideon who saw his weakness and needed a sign, may our children have a God confidence that knows God will equip them to accomplish whatever He asks them to do.
Judges 6:14-17 NIV

March 19

Faith Unlike Gideon whose faith was weak, may our children have a strong and fearless faith that causes them to do as the Lord asks without the need of a sign to confirm what they already know to be true. **Judges 6:37-39 NIV**

March 20

God's Perspective Remind our children that God sees beyond what they are to what they can be in His presence. **Judges 6:12 NIV**

March 21

God's Encouragement When God asks our children to do hard things, may He surprise them with encouragements along the way that help them face their fears, move ahead and accomplish their tasks.
Judges 7:9-11 NIV

March 22

God with Them During times of change, transition or difficult circumstances, may our children know that God is with them and trust Him to meet their needs.
Genesis 32:1 NIV

March 23

Prayers of Faith Unlike Jacob who initially acted out of fear and unbelief, may our children's first response be to pray prayers full of faith, thankfulness and God's Word. **Genesis 32:7-12 NIV**

March 24

Wise Unlike Joseph, may our children be humble, considerate and wise about the things they share with those around them.
Genesis 37:5, 9, 10 NIV

March 25

God's Way and Timing
When our children are rightly motivated to defend a problem that is causing unjust treatment to others, may they look to God for wisdom and guidance to do things His way and in His timing rather than reacting foolishly.

Hope in the Lord Cause our children to put their hope in the Lord who will help them and be a shield around them.

Living Examples May our children be living examples of Jesus love and may they love each other as Christ has loved them.

May our children's acts of service cause those they serve to overflow with expressions of praise and thanksgiving for the Lord.
